CALLING FOR 2-3 VOLUNTEERS

To Run for Sherbrooke's Association Board

The Association needs several volunteers to run for the Board at the March, 2018 General Membership Meeting. Voting can be done at the meeting or by Proxy. (Forms will be made available prior to the meeting.) The term would run from March of 2018 – March of 2020, 2 years.

In the past, meetings were held almost monthly. Our current Board has found that quarterly would probably be sufficient unless a special need should arise. Since our Governing Documents are now legally aligned, the work for the Board going forward should be minimal.

The primary duties of the Board include collecting our annual Dues each year to pay for such things as lighting our entry signs, maintaining the plantings at our entry corners, replacing sign poles if damaged, providing funds for communication vehicles (website and printing costs for notices, newsletters, Directory, etc.), organizing several social activities during the year: i.e. Spring Festival, 4th of July Parade, Back to School Event, Halloween) and acting as a liason between our subdivision and the County (example: Sidewalk Issue).
